DEED OF VARIATION

The parties to this Deed are:

- (1) The Secretary of State for Education ("the Secretary of State"),
- and -
- (2) The Castle Donington College a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 08203218 ("the Academy").

together referred to as the "Parties"

INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into a funding agreement dated 1st October 2012 ("the Funding Agreement") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of an independent school known as Castle Donington College.
- B The Parties now wish to vary and amend the terms of the Funding Agreement and wish to record their agreement as to such variations/amendments to the Funding Agreement by this Deed.

LEGAL AGREEMENT

- Any word or phrase used in this Deed shall, if that word or phrase is defined in the Funding Agreement, bear the meaning given to it in the Funding Agreement.
- The Secretary of State and the Academy agree that with effect from the date of this Deed the Funding Agreement shall be amended in accordance with Schedule 1 to this Deed.
- As varied by this Deed, the Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

Schedule 1

Amendments to the Funding Agreement

- 1. Clause 17 of the Funding Agreement shall be replaced with:
- 17) The planned capacity of the academy is 645 in the age range 11– 16. The Academy will be an all inclusive ability school whose requirements for :
- a) the admission of pupils to the Academy are set out in Annex B to this Agreement;
- b) the admission to the Academy of and support for pupils with SEN and with disabilities (for pupils who have and who do not have statements of SEN) are set out in Annex C to this Agreement;
- c) pupil exclusions are set out in regulations made by virtue of section 51A of the Education Act 2002 (as may be amended from time to time, and includes any successor provisions).
